NETWORKING

Allows your printer to be added to your local network to be shared by multiple users. If a printer has networking capabilities, all you need is an Ethernet cable to start sharing your new machine on your local network.

DUPLEXING (TWO-SIDED PRINTING)

Printers with this feature have the ability to print on both sides of a document automatically. Duplexing is great for presentations and flyers. It can even help to conserve paper.

MONTHLY DUTY CYCLE

A term used to define the maximum number of copies a printer can make in a given time period without voiding the warranty. This number should be used loosely when making a decision on which printer to choose. See “Pages per Month” below for a more detailed explanation.

MEMORY

When you print a document, it is sent from your computer to your printer. The memory inside a printer is where your document is stored before printing. Having more memory allows multiple users to print out a large number of documents quickly and easily, without tying up their computers.

WHEN BUYING A PRINTER, THERE ARE THREE IMPORTANT QUESTIONS TO ASK:

1. Will I need to print color?
2. How many users will be sharing the printer
3. How many pages will I be printing each month?

NUMBER OF USERS:

The number of users that will be sharing a single machine is a good indicator of how large of a printer your office needs. If more than one user will be sharing the printer, you will most likely want to look at a printer with networking. Work team printers are generally best for 2-5 users, while workgroup printers are better suited for 5-10 users. Department-sized printers can be shared with 10+ users.

PAGES PER MONTH: PPM

The number of pages your company needs to print per month is another determining factor when deciding which printer model to choose. The best way to get an accurate understanding of the duty cycle of a printer is to look at how many pages the toner cartridge yields. If you are going to print 10,000 copies per month and the largest toner available for that particular printer is only 2,000 pages, it would be a better choice to upgrade to a larger machine. Generally, larger machines will have higher capacity cartridges, giving you a lower cost per page, costing your company less over time. After determining how many pages your company will be printing, look for a printer with a toner cartridge yield that is at least half that number. For example, if your company prints 5,000 pages per month, you should select a printer with a toner cartridge suitable for at least 2,500 pages.

Once a printer is selected as a candidate for reconditioning, it must undergo a comprehensive inspection process by a Metrofuser trained technician.
